City of Indianapolis Arboricultural Standards

Knowledge and adherence to the following ANSI Standards are required to perform arboricultural work in City of Indianapolis right-of-way or on public properties:

- 1. ANSI Z60.1 American Standard for Nursery Stock.
- 2. ANSI Z133.1-2000 Pruning, Repairing, Maintaining, and Removing Trees, and Cutting Brush Safety Requirements.
- 3. ANSI A300 (Part 1) 2001 Pruning Tree, Shrub, and Other Woody Plant Maintenance Standard Practices (Pruning).

Although ANSI A300 (Part 1) – 2001 Pruning are used as general guidelines for tree care on City of Indianapolis right-of-way and properties, the following changes/additions further define the Standard to reflect actual policy (bolded and underlined words indicate a change in the standard):

Section 4 – Definitions

- **4.20 heading** Heading is **not** an acceptable pruning practice.
- 4.23 internodal cut Internodal cuts are <u>not</u> an acceptable pruning practice.

Section 5 – Pruning Practices

- 5.3.3 A pruning cut that reduces the length of a branch or parent stem shall bisect the angle . . .
- 5.4.1 Wound treatments shall not be used . . .
- **5.5.2** . . . the growth cycles and structure of individual species and the type of pruning **shall** be considered.
- 5.5.4 Not more than 25 percent of the foliage of a branch or limb should be removed when it is cut back to a lateral. That lateral <u>shall</u> be large enough to assume apical dominance.
- **5.5.5** Pruning cuts **shall** be made in accordance with 5.3 Pruning cuts.
- 5.5.6 Heading <u>shall</u> be considered an <u>unacceptable</u> practice . . .
- **5.7.1.3.1** Pruning **shall** be limited to cleaning (5.6.1).
- **5.9.2.1.1** Pruning cuts **shall** be made in accordance with 5.3, Pruning
- **5.9.2.1.1.2** A pruning cut that reduces the length of a or parent stem **shall** bisect the angle . . .
- **5.9.2.1.5** Branches **shall** be cut to laterals or the parent limb and not at a pre-established clearing limit.
