Pennsylvania Paving Project

Begins June 9th

The Restoration of Pennsylvania Street from Arden Drive to Williams Creek Blvd will begin June 9th.

DPW will be milling the surface, removing pavement in the ROW and restoring grass, and resurfacing the street at a consistent width. The work will begin near Arden Drive, and will work its way north. As funds allow, the project may continue to the town's northern boundary at

8000 N. Pennsylvania. The contractor anticipates milling the entire street, and then paving the street in sections. The project is anticipated to be completed at the end of July.

Please move sprinkler heads, large landscape stones, etc. 10-15' from the edge of asphalt...just to be safe. They can be reinstalled after the resurfacing is complete.

There will be delays, lane closures, and inconveniences during the construction. Please be patient and drive slowly!

Rights-of-Way

Encroachment License

Related to the Restoration of Pennsylvania Street, the Town passed an Ordinance requiring an Encroachment License for improvements within the Town Right-of-Way.



This was done to allow residents to continue to landscape and make improvements within the right-of-way, while maintaining the integrity of drainage and public safety.

Residents who wish to make improvements in the right-of-way should submit plans to the Town Engineer for review and compliance. Improvements would include driveways, parking areas, masonry mailboxes, etc. The Encroachment License would then be recorded with Marion County.
