

Pennsylvania Paving Project

Status Report

The Restoration of Pennsylvania Street from Arden Drive to Williams Creek Blvd is well underway, and scheduled to be completed at the end of July.

DPW is currently in the process of milling the existing asphalt. This will leave the roadway in rough condition with the top portion of utility valves and manholes exposed. Please be patient and practice caution while driving on the roadway in this condition.

The asphalt surface replacement is scheduled to begin next Thursday - weather permitting - and will take several days to complete. The concrete work will be complete the first part of next week.

This is one of the biggest public works projects in the town in recent times. As stated before, there will be delays, lane closures, and inconveniences during construction. Thank you for your patience and for driving slowly or finding alternate routes.

Rights-of-Way Encroachment License

Related to the Restoration of Pennsylvania Street, the Town passed an Ordinance requiring an Encroachment License for improvements within the Town Right-of-Way.



This was done to allow residents to continue to landscape and make improvements within the right-of-way, while maintaining the integrity of drainage and public safety.

Residents who wish to make improvements in the right-of-way should submit plans to the Town Engineer for review and compliance. Improvements would include driveways, parking areas, masonry mailboxes, etc. The Encroachment License would then be recorded with Marion County.
