RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MERIDIAN HILLS, INDIANA,
APPROVING AND ADOPTING
TITLE VI IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR 2025

WHEREAS, the Town of Meridian Hills (the “Town”) receives federal funds for many uses and projects;

WHEREAS, the receipt of such funds requires compliance with federal laws and policies;

WHEREAS, the Town strives to proactively meet the minimum compliance requirements established under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the related anti-discrimination statutes and regulations (“Title VI”);

WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Transportation requires all sub-recipients of federal funding to adopt a Title VI Implementation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town, by and through its Town Council, wishes to formally adopt and implement the following policies and procedure for the benefit of all the citizens of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Meridian Hills, Indiana:

1. Subject to inclusion of updated data from the U.S. Census Bureau for the Town, which is presently unavailable due to the U.S. federal government shutdown, the Town’s Title VI Implementation Plan for 2025 is hereby approved and adopted, and the Town Attorney is authorized to insert the updated data from the U.S. Census Bureau when available.

2. The assurances required by the U.S. Department of Transportation, as contained in the adopted Title VI Implementation Plan for 2025, are also approved, and the President of the Town Council is authorized to sign said document where required.

3. The Town’s Title VI Implementation Plan for 2025 will be reviewed, updated, and renewed annually.

4. This Resolution and the Town’s Title VI Implementation Plan for 2025, as adopted, will be posted to the Town’s website.
